

MAJOR MUSTARD'S TRAVELLING SHOW

PUPPET WORKSHOPS :- "Junk Puppets" with Key Stages 1 & 2

Materials useful for making Junk Puppets

ESSENTIALS

The better the quality of the glues and sellotapes etc. the better the quality of the resultant puppets will be.

Per person:

- 2 cardboard tubes (kitchen paper-roll tubes)
- 1 piece of material 30" x 30" (750mm x 750 mm)

Per Group of approx 5 :

- 1 or more mini staplers and spare staples
- 1 or more rolls of strong, clear sellotape (NB. NOT masking tape)
- Strong glue (such as Marvin, PVA, or UHU. Pritt sticks good for use with felt.) NB NOT Gloy or water pastes. Also glue brushes.
- Plenty of COLOURED ART TISSUE PAPER - (NB. NOT Paper Hankie Tissue and NOT Crepe Paper.)

NB. NO PAINTS.

USEFUL ITEMS :

For Heads: cardboard tubes - i.e. kitchen and toilet rolls (**plenty of these**), paper plates (plain) , paper cups (thick not thin) , yoghurt cartons or cottage cheese pots, egg boxes (pulp cardboard NOT polystyrene) .

For Hair: **wool (preferably balls of wool)**, string, scraps of fur , art straws and **pipe cleaners** - plain and coloured, fluffy and thin where possible – **these are very useful.**

For Eyes, Noses and Mouths : pipe cleaners, bottle tops, buttons, beads, corks, caps from plastic bottles, ping pong balls if possible.

For Bodies or Costume : material pieces, minimum size 36" x 36" (900mm x 900mm)

For General Use: match boxes, small cardboard boxes (i.e. OXO or pack of cards size) , paper doilies, and any interesting small objects that are not too big or heavy.
